

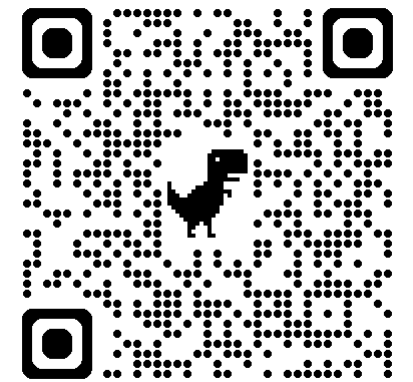

# King's Military Healthcare Ethics Framework

- Step 1 – **identification** of the issues
- Step 2 – **analysis** of perspectives – patient, clinical, legal, societal/military
- Step 3 – **fusion** of analysis
- Step 4 – **decision**
